1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has applied for a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to help finance the proposed Dhaka Water Supply Network Improvement Project (DWSNIP). The Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage Authority (DWASA) is the executing agency of the project under the Local Government Division (LGD) of the ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives and intends to apply part of the proceeds of the loan to payment of consulting services.
2. DWASA now invites expression of interests (EOIs) from eligible consulting firms to provide "Project Development Facilities" consulting services under the proposed project, over a period of 18 (Eighteen) months from July 2018 to January 2020. The consulting services will develop project to verify the feasibility, provide design, specification, cost estimation and bid documents for improvement in Waste Water services at Rayer bazar Dhaka. The consultant will conduct the necessary survey and analysis to deliver (i) situation analysis report; (ii) feasibility study report; (iii) Detailed Project Report; and (iv) Bid documents.
3. Interested international consulting firms must be from ADB member countries having prior experience in providing consulting services on externally financed similar projects in the region or national consulting firms, may form a joint venture (JV) or an association for expressing interest. When expressing interest, a JV or an association must nominate one firm as the lead firm who will interact directly with the PMU as the appointed representative of the JV or association. No individual firm proposed as the lead firm (international or national) should not participate in more than one group.
4.
